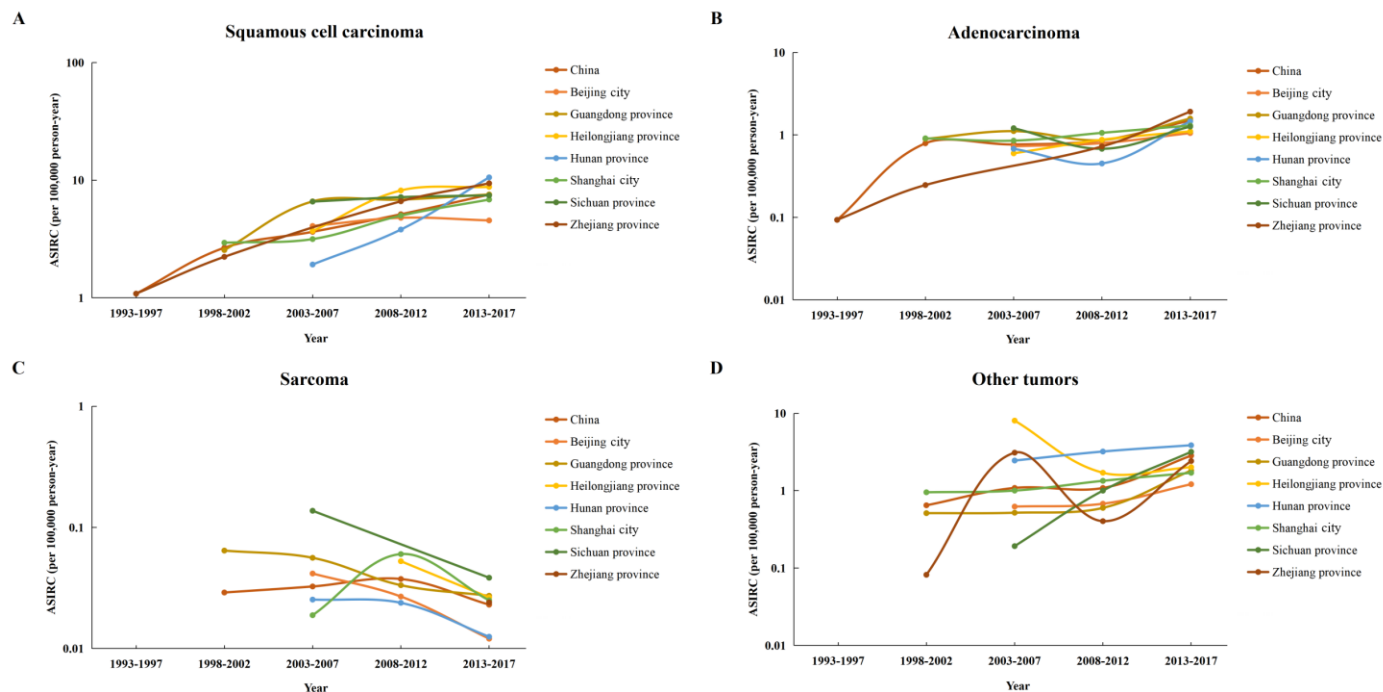

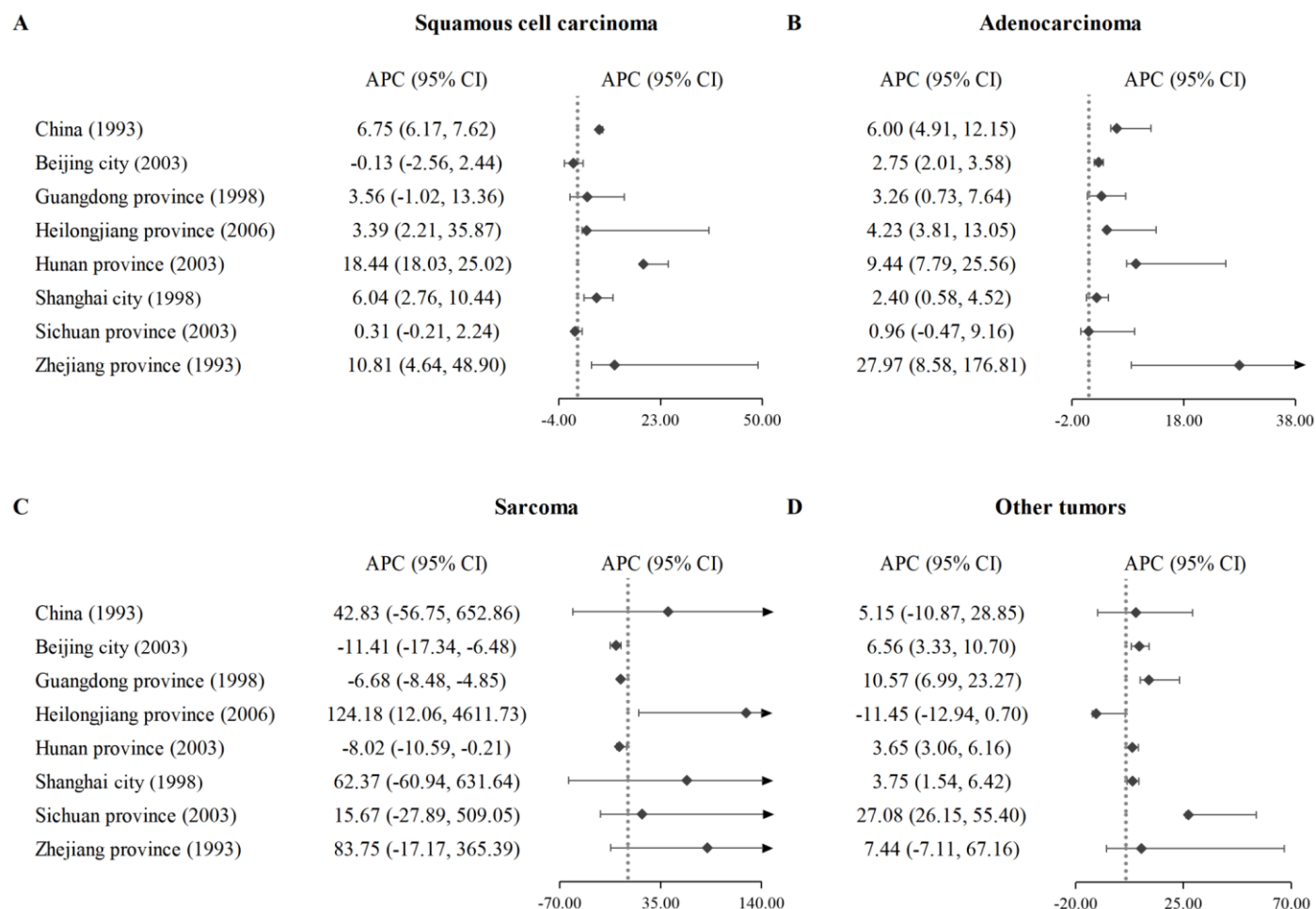
A, Squamous cell carcinoma

B, Adenocarcinoma

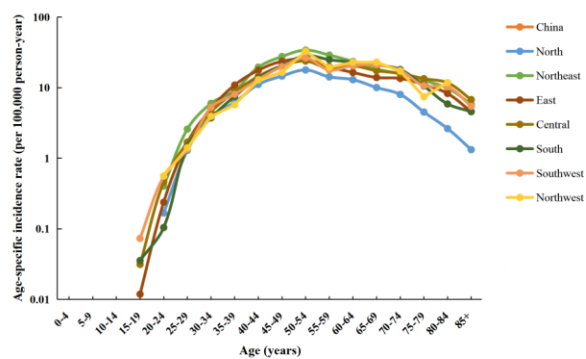
C, Sarcoma

APC, annual percent change; ASIRC, age-standardized incidence rate adjusted by the Chinese standard population in 2000; CI, confidence interval.

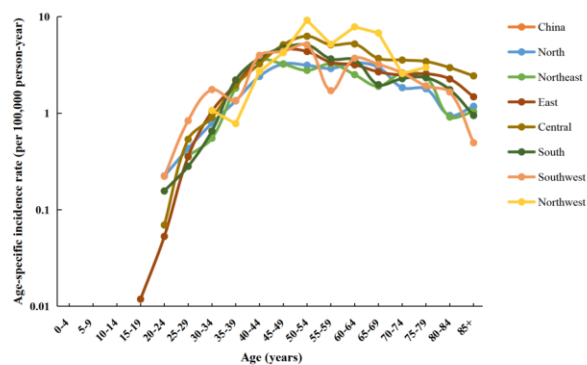

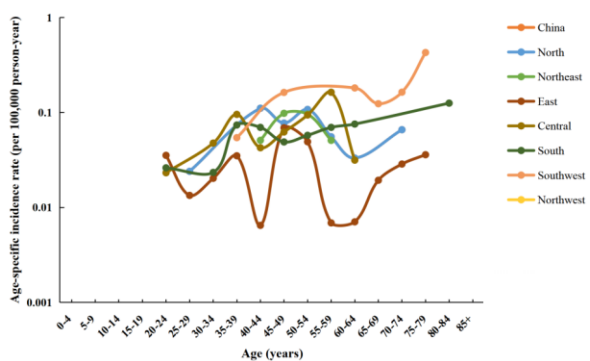

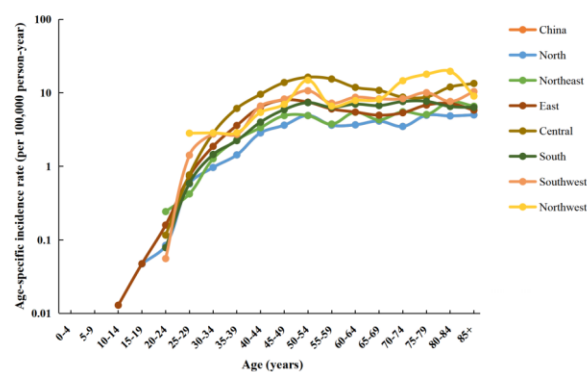
